# Remarks

# 1 Introduction

Thanks for using this device. It is a car/portable GPS navigator combines with other functions which will be detailed explained in this manual. Please carefully read it before using and this manual is applicable for this device only.

## 1.1 Features

- Support GPS navigation

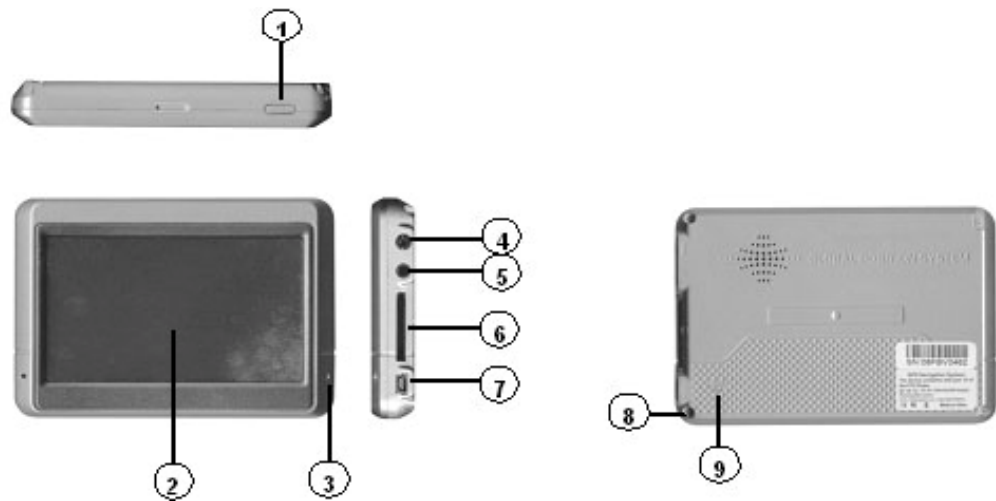
- Support WMV/AVI/ASF format video file
- Support MP3/WMA format audio file
- FM transmitter: can transmit about 10 meter in a tract of land(with external headphone antenna). Transmit frequency from 76Mhz to 108Mhz.
- Lyric (LRC) display synchronously
- Support JPG/BMP format picture browse
- Support TXT format eBook reading
- Support SD/MMC Card
- Built-in speaker
- Mini USB port

## 1.3 Illustration



1. Power button      Start up / shut down
2. LCD screen
3. LED                  Display charging state
- 4, External TMC antenna port (optional)      connect to TMC antenna
- 5, Earphone Jack      Connect to stereo Earphone
- 6, SD/MMC Card slot      Insert the SD/MMC Card into it
- 7, USB port      Connect to PC through MINI USB cable/charging device by power adapte.
- 8, Rope race      Used to hang the touch pen on it.
- 9, Reset hole      Reboot the system



## 2 Usage on the Computer

### 2.1 **Link the device with the computer through USB cable connection to do data transferring between the device and PC.**

- Make sure the power-on condition of the device.
- Mini USB port to the device and standard USB port to the PC USB host.

#### **Data transferring**

- Connect the device with the computer through USB cable.
- Double click 'My Computer' icon then find two 'Removable Disk'. The first one represents the device, and another represents SD/MMC card.
- Double click any one of the 'Removable Disk' to enter the folder then you can do copy, delete or edit data.

[NOTE] Please do not pull out the USB cable while doing data transferring or

else the data will be lost.

## **2.2 Disconnection**

Please do according to the system notice to remove the USB cable.

- Left click USB icon on the taskbar then click the pop-up notice
- After seeing the safety notice remove the USB cable.

[NOTE] While connecting with the computer other functions of the GPS device will pause.

## 3 Basic Operation

### 3.1 Battery

Please fully charge while the first time use. The GPS device has built-in Lithium battery. And you can use the AC adapter or car adapter provided in the package to charge at home or on car.

[NOTE] The LED indicator will be red alight while charging and it will turn green after completely charging.

- AC adapter – DC port is for the power jack of the device and the other side is for electrical outlet.

- Car adapter – DC port is for the power jack of the device and the other side is for the cigar-lighter on the car.

[NOTE] Please use the car adapter after cranking up or else the current will destroy the GPS device.

## 3.2 Power Button

To enter the sleeping mode to save the power, please press the power button for 1 seconds and there is a message “entering sleeping mode” displayed, then screen would be shut off, but the red light is on.

To start up the system, please press the power button again, the screen will display the last picture showed before sleep automatically in the time of starting up.

To shut down the system, please press the power button for 2 seconds and there is a message “power off” displayed, then screen would be shut off

**[NOTE] The device can be normally charged while powered off, and please keep power-off if no use for a long time.**

### 3.3 Restart

If no response to any operation please try to restart the device through pushing On/off button

**[NOTE]** This operation may cause data loss so please backup significant files or data in advance.

## 3.4 Use in the car

While use the GPS device in your car, please use the Window mounting kit and fixing clip provided in the package to set the device on panel under the windshield.

[NOTE] Please carefully choose the GPS device setting position.

- Do not disturb the eye sight of the driver.
- Make sure well fixing.
- Keep away from SRS airbag place

## 3.5 Touch Pen

Please keep it carefully.

- Point to point choosing target icon
- Pen point dragging on the screen to target area or direction

## 3.6 SD/MMC Card

The SD/MMC card use on the device saved map software and data, and it can also be used as mass storage to keep files. Just inserting it to the card slot on the device. But while file reading, please do not take out the card.

[NOTE] Please keep the card away from corrosive, overhigh or low temperature

and direct sunlight. And inserting the card from right direction.

## 4 Main Functions

There are 6 menus in main menu: Navigation. Music, Video. E-book, Photo, System.





## 4.1 Navigation

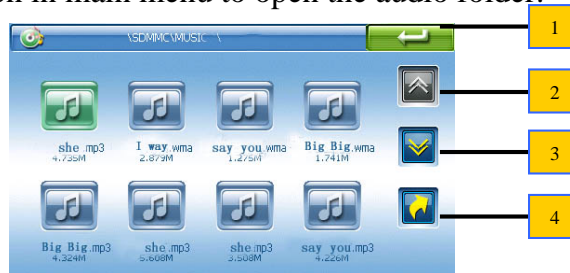
- The intelligent navigation system used on the device does exact positions—fix through internal high sensitivity receiver, An optimal path would be figured

out automatically and will help the user to reach the destination safely within shortest time.

- The routes recommended are for reference and it all up to your choice to do according to that or not.
- About signal receiving – some factors may affect the signal receiving, such as weather, tall or dense buildings (in tunnel, underground parking and viaduct) and no satellite signal.

## 4.2 Music

Click “music” icon in main menu to open the audio folder.

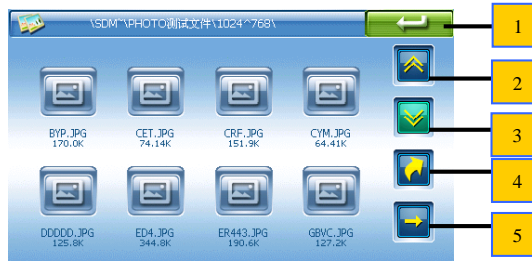

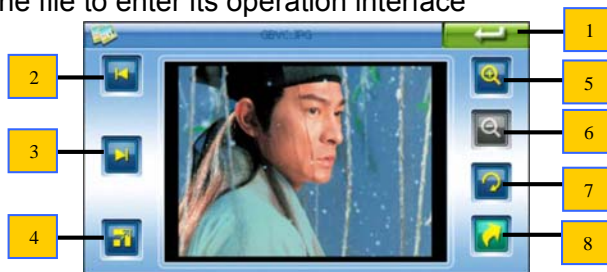
## 4.5 Photo

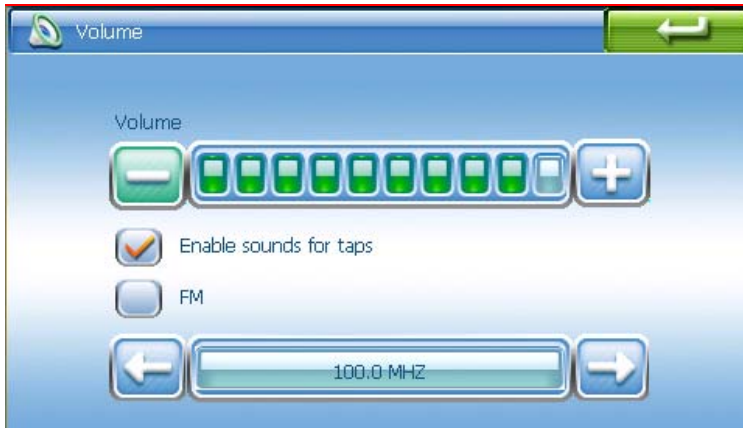
## 4.6 System

Please click “system” icon in main menu to enter system setting interface



## 4.6.1 Volume and FM transmitter

Click "volume" icon to enter its setting interface



- Click '+' or '-' icon to increase or decrease the speaker volume
- Choose to open or close sounds for taps
- Choose to turn on or turn off FM transmitter

- Click ‘←’ or ‘→’ to adjust the FM frequency to be the same as the FM frequency in your car. The voice on GPS device will be transferred to the car speaker.

## 4.6.2 Power

Click “power” icon to enter its setting interface

- The level bar shows current battery power
- Click ‘→’ or ‘←’ icon to set the auto power off time



## 4.6.3 Backlight

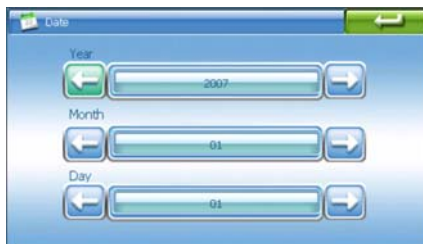
Click “backlight” icon to enter its setting interface

- Click ‘+’ or ‘-’ icon to set brightness level
- Click ‘→’ or ‘←’ icon to set the auto light off time



## 4.6.4 Date time

Click “date time” icon to enter its setting

## 4.6.5 Language

Click "language" icon to enter its setting interface, then click '→' or '←' icon to choose a language.



## 4.6.6 Sys Info.



Click “sys info.” icon to enter its interface showing detailed system information.

- Click ‘Calibration’ button to center screen calibration interface. Pen touch the cross cursor at the center it would move according to following path: center-left top-left bottom-right bottom-right top-center. Then do as the system prompt on the screen to exit and return to the system setting interface.
